Pedigrees and pictures of the consignments are in this catalog and accompanying advertising. Look them over and then make plans to bid in person or by proxy at the prestigious Spotlight Sale!

PROXY BIDDING:

If you cannot be at the Spotlight Sale in person, proxy bidding is available by sending a letter to the ADGA Association Manager, P.O. Box 865, Spindale, NC 28160-0865. State the highest amount you will pay for a particular consignment(s). Enclose your check or money order for that amount. The ADGA Association Manager will see to it that your bid is placed as if you were placing it yourself and will try to buy your choice(s) for the lowest amount possible. All bids are held in strictest confidence. Send enough money - you won't want to miss out for lack of a few dollars.

TERMS:

The Spotlight Sale Committee has selected animals of the finest breeding available. Local veterinarians will inspect the animals prior to the sale and monitor their condition up to the sale. Announcements will take precedence over all other information. All animals will be available for inspection prior to the sale and have been CAE tested - results of test will be available.

The Spotlight Sale Committee, auctioneer and ADGA act as agent only and are not in any way responsible for animal health or registration, but will collect health and registration certificates. Registration certificates will be forwarded to ADGA for transfer once checks have cleared.

The sale committee has accepted consignments with reasonable bottom limits and bid animals to this hold price if necessary. These hold prices are fair market value for the quality of stock offered. Bidding up of consignment over the pre-

set hold price or bidding in by the consignor or his/her agent are unethical. It is also unethical for the consignor to make public or private promises to include additional animals, since this sale is for the individuals listed in this catalog.

Pedigrees, production records, linear appraisal scores and national show wins listed in the catalog are provided through the ADGA Performance Pedigree database. Additional and updated information may be provided in advertisements and announced at the sale and are furnished by the consignor only. Bucks who have semen collected and frozen will be announced prior to sale.

Animals will not be sold in lot number order. Sale order is determined by the sale committee and will be announced prior to the sale.

Shipping arrangements can be made in advance of the sale with the host committee or the Spotlight Sale co-chairs. Arrangements should be made prior to the sale. Animals will be released after the sale once they have been paid for by check, money order or credit card and a release is provided by the sale staff. Animals become the responsibility of the buyer immediately upon sale.

As per the recommended trade practices for ADGA members, the seller guarantees the fertility of bucks sold. Should a buck prove to be a non-breeder the buyer shall provide sufficient proof such as a statement from a veterinarian that said buck is sterile. The seller shall have the option of making satisfactory exchange or refunding the purchase price. In no case shall the seller pay any shipping charges involved in the exchange. If the animal is a doe, there is no guarantee of fertility except where hermaphroditism becomes apparent when the animal reaches breeding age. A doe sold as bred is not guaranteed to be pregnant but only to have normally accepted service from a buck.
