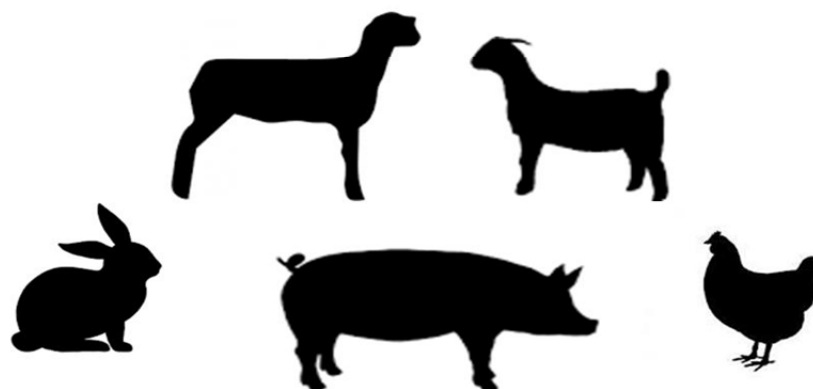

Goats

Our meat goat herd consists of high-percentage Boer goats that are registered with the American Boer Goat Association. Application for registration is available for all doe kids at an additional cost of \$25.00. Although our herd is has an emphasis on functionality and performance, there are numerous show quality animals being offered as well.

An exceptional dappled fullblood buck, Hobby Razzle Dazzle C1308, sired all of the fall-born kids. Razzle Dazzle has a pedigree that goes back to legacies such as Bon Joli/Lazy S-T Copperhead and 10B2B Backdraft *Ennobled*. Spring-born kids are sired by SOBG Soggy Oaks Rebels Bigshot which was the second-highest indexing fullblood junior buck at the 2016 PA Annual Performance Test

Please be aware that our goats have been vaccinated for Caseous Lymphadenitis (CL abscesses) and have been exposed to sore mouth. They have the potential to introduce these diseases to your herd. Please take proper and adequate measures for quarantine to maintain herd health and biosecurity.

Sheep

This year's commencement sale offers a variety of sheep including Dorper, Dorset, Hampshire and several crosses. Our Dorper ram is fullblood and was purchased from Lone Star Dorpers located in Weston, Massachusetts. His dam is national champion ewe Riverwood Farm 5244, which has produced a number of champion lambs for Lone Star Dorpers. Our polled Dorset ram is from K Bar K Farm in Petersburg, Pennsylvania, who has continually selected sheep for lambing ease and lamb vigor. He is performance- tested, showing high EBV (values) for weaning-weight and post weaning-weight.

There are mature ewes, both fall-born and spring born lambs, ram-lambs, and wethers to select from. The crossbred offerings are noted for heterosis, or hybrid-vigor, contributing to growth rate and carcass characteristics, as well as improved milking quality and ability. A long breeding season combined with excellent maternal instinct allows these ewes to increase the fertility of your flock. This selection can meet the needs of producers from several target markets including pasture-based, terminal-purpose, brood ewe, or show.
