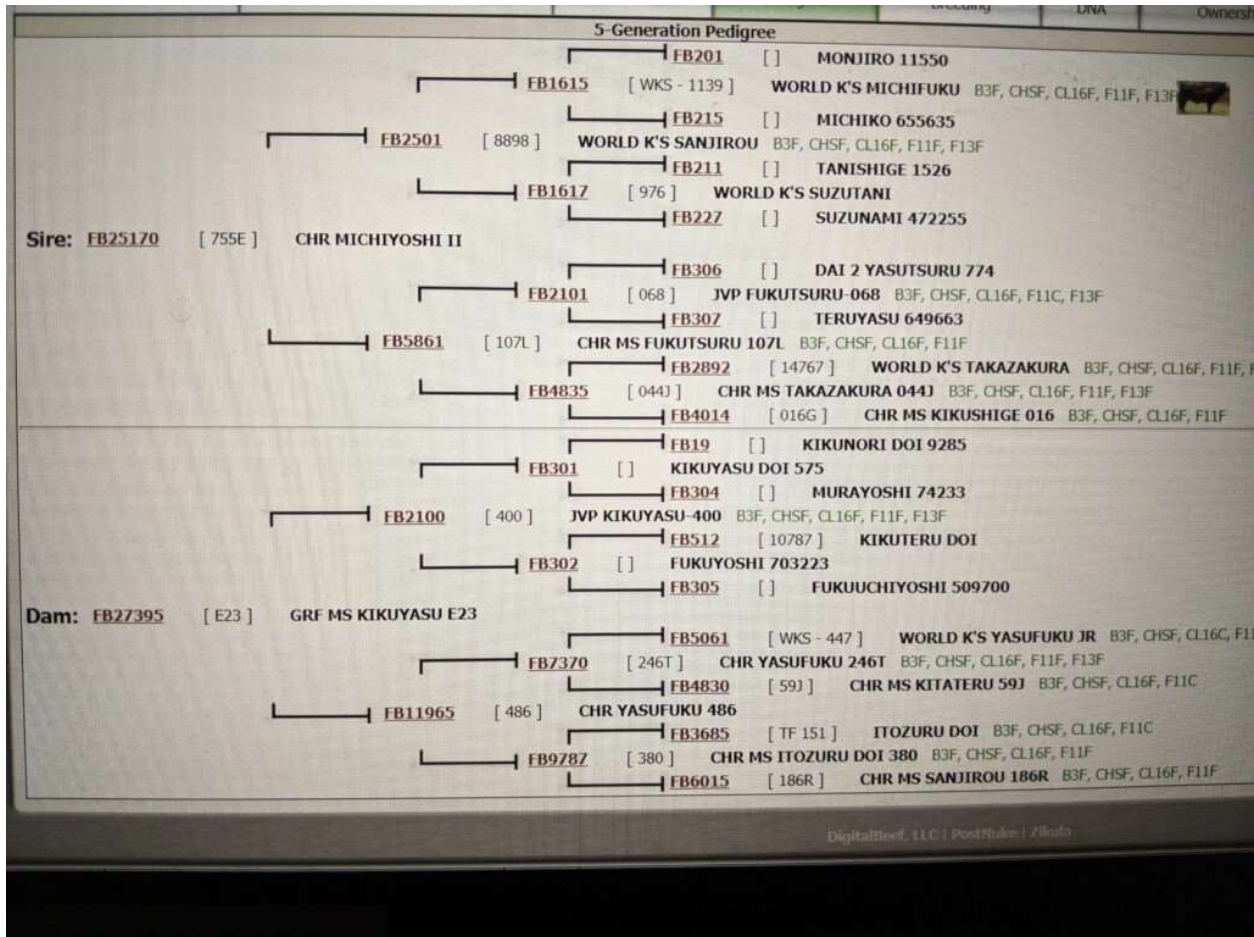


Replacement for Lot 69 Music City Celebration Sale. Terms and consignor sale as catalog



Don't shy away from this younger heifer, as she is equally as fine as the heifer she replaced. F58 was slated to be a replacement in our herd, however I like to give Tim one of the best. GRF Ms Michiyoshi II F58 (FB44464) is a fullblood black wagyu, born 4/17/2019, AA on the SCD fat test and 7 for tenderness, and clean for all recessive traits. Her dam GRF MS Kikuyasu E23 (FB27395), is an excellent young cow who raises a great calf and has a flush history that stands on her own. E23 is sired by Kikuyasu-400, who is known for his large framed cattle with excellent phenotype which can be seen in both E23 and her daughters. The bottom side of F58s pedigree is built for size, where the top side has carcass traits from every angle. F58's sire is Michiyoshi II (FB25170), who has excellent ribeye size and marbling characteristics. He is backed by Sanjiro, Michifuku, Takazakura, and Suzutani, whom all have their place in carcass trait history. F58's flush sisters are high on my list for docility, size, fertility, and a delicious future. To put a cherry on top, F58 is carrying an embryo from GRF MS SHIGESHIGETANI C04 and sired by HIRASHIGETAYASU J2351. The Japanese tested J2351 and found that 80% of his progeny will grade AA5, the highest possible grade on the Japanese scale. This is a future donor to build a herd around with a bonus calf to boot!
