From I-85, take Exit 204, go south on Hwy. 96 for 1.1 mile, turn left on Fairport Rd., go 2.4 miles, right on Cannady Mill Rd., sale ¼ mile on left @ Granville County Livestock Arena. Also from jct. of Hwy. 96 & 56 @ Wilton, take Hwy. 96 north 2 miles, turn right on Cannady Mill Rd., arena approx. 6 miles on right. Watch for cattle auction arrows leading way to sale.

(38) **Red Angus cow/calf pairs** – all 3rd calvers, calves born fall and early winter of 2019. This set of cattle will be exposed back to Red Angus bulls prior to sale.

(112) **Bred Red Angus cows** coming w/3rd calf, bred to Red Angus bulls, due to start calving August – 1st November.

(49) **Red Angus open heifers**, home raised, average wt. approx. 800#, born off above listed cows, thick, short hair, will make a real set of mama cows for the future.

(60) **Red Angus & (6) Black steers**, average wt. 810# on 3-9-2020, non-implanted, have been on hay, Bartlett Feeds, medium frame,

ready to go to feedyard, will be sold by 100 wt. w/2% shrink on the truck, these steers will be loaded anytime after sale w/24 hr. notice excluding Sunday. Buyer will have option to take the (60) Red Angus & include (6) Black steers. Should gain approx. 2# per day per head until loaded out.

(9) **Red Angus herd sires** – thick, medium frame, short hair, some of these bulls came with the herd that was purchased from Kansas 2 years back, (1) came from John Langdon, several were purchased with the help of Johnny Rogers from sale in Tennessee.

This is a complete dispersal of B & B Properties Red Angus cattle herd (due to present health

issues of owner). Glenn bought these cattle as 1st calf heifers from genetics from Kansas area, some of these cattle will be carrying a brand from the original ranch they were raised on. The cattle have been grazing fescue pasture, wintered on hay with protein blocks, up to date on kill virus vaccines & de-worming, medium frame, good feet, good udders, these will be the keeping kind for years to come.

All Cattle Will be Screened for Reproductive Soundness By DVM Sam Galphin. All cattle 18 months of age & older will be EID




What a pretty sight – green grass & red cows. If this is not the good life –U- tell me why.




A big handful of the 28 fall babies that go with the mamas & may be one in the oven.

Herd in Vance County behind Kerr Vance Academy – those kids learn a lot right here that they will carry with them for life time.




Here stands 1/2 of any herd right here & easy going to boot.
